

Terms & Conditions for Weekly Classes

1 To reserve a place in an evening class, please inform Moor to Sea Arts.

2 Moor to Sea Arts works on a three term year:
Autumn Term September to December
Spring Term January to Easter
Summer Term Easter to July

3 Students register on a termly basis. Term lengths will vary.

4 To secure a place in any Weekly Class the fee must be paid IN FULL at registration.

5 Students may pay in half-termly instalments. In this case the place is secured for the half-term paid for, and reserved for the second half of the term. The second instalment must be paid by or during the last session of the first half-of the term. Moor to Sea Arts reserves the right to re-allocate a place if the balance of the termly fee is not paid at this time.

6 'Trial' Sessions: Prospective students are entitled to attend one weekly class session without committing to booking for the whole term. The fee for this session is £7. This does not secure a place in the weekly class (see point 4).

7 You will receive a receipt for the fees paid ~ this is also your confirmation of registration.

8 Places will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis.

9 Cheques are payable to 'Moor to Sea Arts'.

10 The course fee includes all tuition, demonstrations, coffee, tea and biscuits throughout the session. Students bring their own art materials.

11 If for any reason you miss the course we are unable to refund the fee. In registering you accept these terms.

12 Moor to Sea Arts reserves the right to cancel classes at its discretion. In this event as much notice as possible will be given and any relevant fees paid to us will be refunded in full. Moor to Sea Arts will not be liable for any additional cost or expense.

13 Personal possessions remain your responsibility throughout the course. We suggest arranging your own insurance if you are bringing items of particular value.

14 LOYALTY SCHEME

The Loyalty Scheme is available to students who have attended Moor to Sea Arts Weekly Classes for 3 consecutive terms.

The scheme allows eligible students to pay reduced fees for the term if they know in advance that they will not be able to attend specified sessions.

- Eligible students must state at the beginning of the term, in writing, that they wish to take advantage of the scheme.
- Prior notice, of at least 8 days, must be given of the dates which the student will not be attending. No refund will be given for other missed sessions.
- The scheme applies only to evening classes which the student does not attend.
- The student will specify which session(s) they will not be attending.
- The number of free sessions allowable each term is as follows:
Autumn Term: fee reduction of 1 week allowable
Spring Term: fee reduction of 1 week allowable
Summer Term: fee reduction of 2 weeks allowable.

Further loyalty concessions may be available for students who have attended for at least 6 terms. Please discuss these options with Moor to Sea Arts.
